Guru Arjan Dev School Policies

Attendance Policy

- Regular attendance is critical to success of student.
- Parents are requested to make sure that their child(ren) reach the Guru Arjan Dev School by 10:30 a.m. every Sunday so that they can fully participate in the class and make satisfactory progress.
- Teachers will not repeat lessons for students who miss class. It is the parent's responsibility to make sure that their child makes up any missed work by doing additional work at home.
- Excessive absenteeism will result in the student failing the class.

Student Code of Conduct

All students are expected to act in a manner which will not hinder their learning or the learning of their fellow students. It is the parent's and student's responsibility to make sure that the student follows the Code of Conduct specified below.

1. Show respect for school, teachers and classmates.
 - a. Do not talk in class without the teacher's permission.
 - b. Enter and leave the room quietly.
 - c. Come to class prepared with all supplies and homework complete.
 - d. Respect other people's opinions and differences.
 - e. Speak without using negative comments or improper language.
 - f. Follow directions of all teachers and sewadars.
2. Participate in all classroom activities.
3. Be on-time for class. **Students coming more than 15 minutes late will not be allowed to attend the class.**
4. Do your own work. Do not copy others answers on homework, quizzes and tests. All incidents of copying will result in grade of zero and possibly a meeting with the parents.
5. Wear proper clothing and cover your head while in the School & Gurudwara.
6. After classes are over every student must go to the Gurdwara Darbar Hall.

Student Progress Evaluation

The teacher will evaluate each student throughout the year. Evaluation will be based on tests, quizzes, homework, class participation and attendance. The results of these evaluations will be averaged at the end of the year. The student must have an average of at least 75% and a minimum attendance of 70% to move onto the next course level.

Students who do not demonstrate satisfactory progress based on class average or the final exam will repeat the same course during the next school year.

Parent/Teacher Meetings

Commitment and involvement of parents is a key ingredient to the success of the children. From time to time, Parent/Teacher meetings may be called to discuss student progress and any school issues. All parents are expected to participate.
